### GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1) Now that we have finished reading the Song of Solomon, select one of the following scriptures that would best describe your love relationship with our Heavenly Father and share why:
  - Songs of Solomon 2:4 - “He brought me to the banqueting house, and His banner over me was love.”
  - Songs of Solomon 2:10 - “My beloved spoke, and said to me: “Rise up, my love, my fair one, and come away.”
  - Songs of Solomon 4:9 – “You have ravished my heart...You have ravished my heart with one look of your eyes.”
  - Songs of Solomon 8:6 – “Set me as a seal upon your heart; As a seal upon your arm; For love is as strong as death.”
